**Warning: Phishing Attempt Circulating**

There is a fraudulent text and/or recorded message currently circulating. It is a phishing attempt. The message, pretending to be from Chase Bank, instructs the recipient that their debit card has been deactivated or blocked, and they should call 239-666-2523. When the recipient calls this number, they are asked to enter their debit card number, PIN and CVV code on the back of the card.

If you receive this message, or one like it, please do not call the number listed. This is an attempt at stealing your account information. Please note, Coosa Valley Credit Union will never ask for your account information over the phone or via text. If you did receive a message like this and called the number, please call 800-500-1044 to report your card lost/stolen. Also, please call us at Coosa Valley Credit Union to order your new debit card. Please remember to monitor your account information either online or via Audio Response.
